SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Manuscripts must be original and unpublished.
- Simultaneous submissions are not permitted.
- Submissions should follow the *MLA Handbook* (9th edition).
- Manuscripts should be anonymised for double-blind peer review.
- Include an abstract (150–200 words) and 5–7 keywords.
- Figures, tables, and images should be supplied in high resolution with appropriate permissions where applicable.



PUBLICATION ETHICS

The journal is committed to the highest standards of publication ethics. All submissions will undergo plagiarism screening and editorial assessment before peer review. Cases of plagiarism, duplicate publication, data fabrication, or other forms of academic misconduct will result in immediate rejection.



OPEN ACCESS POLICY

Co(n)texts follows a Diamond Open Access model. No submission, processing, or publication charges are levied on authors, and all published content is freely accessible to readers worldwide.
