About the University

Central University of Haryana is one of the fifteen new Central Universities established by Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India in XI Five Year Plan (2007-2012) under the Central University Act-2009 of the Parliament. The University has been accredited with “A” grade in the second cycle of NAAC assessment in August 2023. The University has been listed among the top 150-200 Universities in NIRF ranking. The University is fully funded by University Grant Commission (UGC). Permanent Campus of the University is situated in 484 acres of land at Jant-Pali Villages, Mahendergarh district of Haryana from where CUH is running its academic operations. Presently the University offers 83 academic programmes (UG/PG/Research).

Department of Psychology

Department of Psychology is one of the Dept. under the School of Humanities and Social Sciences, Central University of Haryana started from the academic year 2014-15. The Department is presently supported by a dedicated team of six permanent faculty & eight guest faculty members who are actively involved in academic advancement. The Department offers a student-friendly environment to foster academic growth and provides research orientation required for Higher Education. The dept. offers five academic programmes, (M.A., B.Sc.(Hons.), Ph.D., & two RCI approved courses-PGDRP & ADCGC). The Department is fully equipped with experimental instruments, psychological tests, & computer labs. It also focuses on audio-visual aids for classroom teaching. The Department organizes academic, research & extension activities such as seminars, workshops, lectures, internships etc. Thrust areas of the Dept. includes personality, psychological testing, rehabilitation, organization behaviour, positive psychology, biopsychology & health psychology.

About the Research Methodology Course

The main objective of the Research Methodology Course is to have a detailed discussion on the significance of new dimensions in the area of research related to field of Social Sciences especially in the discipline of Psychology, Sociology, and Anthropology for the Ph.D. and Post-Doctoral scholars of colleges and post-graduate departments of various universities as well as research institutes. Along with the theoretical and empirical aspects of all disciplines, the workshop intends to define the research problem, formulations of the hypothesis, collection of the data, data collection methods, tools and techniques for analysis, and various aspects related to report writing. More specifically the course aims to address the following objectives:

1. To familiarize the participants with the philosophical and theoretical dimensions of the fundamentals of research.
2. To help in learning the application of advanced statistical concepts in the analysis of data.
3. To acquaint the participants with different types of data sources and means of accessing them.
4. To interact with the participants on various research methods and techniques of data collection, analysis, and interpretation.
5. To make the researcher comfortable with the application of the quantitative and qualitative tools in research.
6. To draw valid inferences and meaningful conclusions from statistical analysis.

Major topics to be covered in the Research Methodology Course

1. Research design for social sciences and management research
2. Training of software to analyze the data
3. Descriptive and inferential statistics
4. Qualitative and Quantitative Research Methods
5. Ethnographical, Phenomenological, and Ethnomethodological Perspectives
6. Methodological tools for primary and secondary data
7. Research report writing and field survey
8. Use of Statistical Softwares

Resource Person/ Experts

The Resource Persons/Experts are prominent Professors and erudite scholars in the field of Psychology having the expertise of Research Methodology with excellent knowledge of various softwares. They have extensive experience in the applications of statistical tools in data analysis.

Target group

The main target group for the training program would be Ph.D./PDF Research Scholars from Indian universities and from various academic institutions who are engaged in research.

Specific Objectives of Research Methodology Course

1. To enhance theoretical, practical, predictive, and preventive research knowledge across disciplines.
2. To develop skills in research area selection, design formulation, variable operationalization, and data collection.
3. To promote research ethics, plagiarism prevention, and data integrity practices.
4. To familiarize participants with advanced statistical software and qualitative analysis methods.
5. To encourage interdisciplinary research collaboration and methodologies based on the Indian Knowledge System.

Learning outcomes of the Research Methodology Course

1. After attending RMC, participants will get an in-depth understanding of research and its implications in the decision-making process.
2. Gain a better understanding of how to prepare a research proposal.
3. Design reliable and valid questionnaires for the collection of data.
4. Use descriptive and predictive statistical tools using robust analytical softwares like SPSS, and E-Views.
5. Participants will be familiar with univariate, bivariate, and multivariate statistical techniques.

Eligibility Criteria

The course is meant for research scholars who are currently pursuing their /Ph.D./ PDF in Social Sciences discipline in UGC recognized Universities and research institutes across India.

Intake

The intake for the course shall be a maximum of 30 (10 from local, 10 from Haryana state other than local, and 10 from outside the Haryana state) participants from social science disciplines.

Important points

1. Registration will be done on a first come first serve basis.
2. No leave of any kind is permitted during the course period.
3. A personal laptop is compulsory for every participant.

Certificate

At the end of the Research Methodology Course, the certificate will be issued to the participants who will complete the assignments and attendance.

Registration fee

There is NO registration fee for the participants.

Accommodation & Travel allowance

- Accommodation will be provided to the outstation participants only.
- Breakfast, lunch, and refreshments will be served to all the participants.

How to reach the venue

If you are coming from Delhi or Gurgaon (Distance-125Kms.), come through NH-08 and after crossing Dharuhera, turn right for Rewari. Then, follow the Mahendergarh road until you reach Mahendergarh. From there continue for 8 kms. towards Charkhi Dadri and you will find CUH Gate No.1 on Road. From there you can reach University Academic Block & Administration Block. If you are coming from Jaipur (Distance-190Kms.), then reach Mahendergarh via Behror and then Narnaul. Those coming via Rohtak, may reach University via Charkhi Dadri as University is at the distance of just 27 km from Charkhi Dadri on Mahendergarh Road.

Tourist attractions near CUH

1. DHOSI HILL

Dhosi Hill is an extinct volcano, standing alone at the northwest end of the Aravalli mountain range. It is a part with height varying from about 345 to 470 meters from the surrounding land, 740 meters from the sea level. It has a temple, pond, fort and caves on the top and forest. The Aravalli range is Precambrian Malani igneous suite of rocks that have been dated at 732 Ma BP (million years before present).



2. MAA CHILLAY MANDIR

Khudana is one of the largest villages in the Mahendergarh district (in terms of land). It is well-known for the hilltop Kuldevi temple.



3. BABA JAI RAM DAS MANDIR, PALI

Baba Jai Ram Das Mandir, Pali is one of the most popular religious places in the district. People across the state visit the temple. Besides the temple, there is a park, pond and a Dharamshala to stay. Every year temple committee organizes a fair along with competitions in different sports. A cricket ground, a gymnasium is also there.



4. TOMB OF IBRAHIMKHANQADRI

It was built on Sher Shah Suri's (1540-45 AD) orders on his grandfather's grave, Ibrahim Khan Sur, who died in 1518 AD at Narnaul. The mausoleum is placed on a square platform. It features a lovely entrance on the eastern side that appears to be made of Hindu temple sandh as beautiful carvings. Small panels of low relief carving in red sand stone edged with grey limestone ornament the facade, split into two levels by a strip of moulding. The dome is balanced by four octagonal cupolas placed at the four corners of the terrace.
